### 61st Annual Meeting Recap

On Friday March 3, 2022, we hosted our **61st Annual Meeting** at the Executive Banquet Hall in Newark Delaware. After dinner, the meeting was called to order by Community Powered Chairman Gerald Connor.



During the past year, Community Powered welcomed 755 new members, driving total memberships to 8,469, funded 407 loans for a total of \$15.7 million dollars, assisted members with over 98 thousand in-person branch transactions, answered over 25 thousand calls with 96% answered in less than 1 minute and ended with a net worth ratio of 12.15%.

This year we gave back to our community with a clothing and school supply drive as well as attended 20+ local events. We have formed new partnerships with area businesses and look forward to further strengthening community efforts.

Gerald Connor and Leonard Hiltz were reelected to the board by unanimous consent, and the evening closed with the awarding of some awesome door prizes! If you couldn't attend this year, make sure you get tickets next year.

## **23rd Annual Scholarship Contest**

Community Powered Federal Credit Union will grant **THREE \$1,500 SCHOLARSHIPS** to qualifying high school seniors. We encourage all qualified students to apply for these scholarships. Applicants must be high school seniors, graduating in 2023 from a public, private, or parochial school, and a member of Community Powered.

#### **Essay Requirement**

Please submit a typed essay, no less than 250 words and no greater than 500 words, OR a video essay no less than 2 minutes long and no greater than 5 minutes long, based upon one of the following topics:

- If you were the Marketing Manager of Community Powered Federal Credit Union, how would you encourage college-age students to use the services of the Credit Union?
- How can parents help their children achieve financial independence?
- What can high schools do to better prepare graduates to understand and manage their financial responsibilities?

Application packets will be available on **Friday, March 31, 2023,** in all branches, and all entries must be received no later than **Friday, May 26, 2023,** in order to be eligible. Winners will be contacted by the Credit Union in mid to late June. All entries will be judged by an independent agency whose decisions are final. In addition to the essay, all entries from students must include: a letter of recommendation, SAT scores, list of community service activities, and any awards they have received. ### **Protect Your Account With These Simple Tips**

Fraud can happen to anyone. As a reminder, Community Powered will NEVER contact you and ask for Access to your account, Your online password or PIN, Personal security codes, or Answers to security questions. This information should ALWAYS be kept confidential. It is for your use only – do not share it with anyone. If someone asks you for this information, question their identity.



The best course of action is to hang up and call **Community Powered** at **(302) 368-2396**. Please call this safe number to report any suspicious calls with as much detail as possible so we can continue to protect our members. Here are some other tips to keep your information safe:

#### Make sure you're logging in to a secure website

Community Powered's website address starts with https, not http. The "s" means the site is secure and your credit card and personal information is protected. Also, most website browsers will often feature a padlock icon near the secured web address.

#### Don't transfer money to someone you don't know

If you are asked to use gift cards, cryptocurrency, prepaid debit cards, or digital currency to resolve fraud or some financial issue, it's likely a scam.

### Use unique passwords for every online account and change them regularly

Don't use easily identifiable information such as: mother's maiden name, address, date of birth, or your telephone number.

#### Be wary of connecting to public Wi-Fi networks

If you are simply browsing the internet, you're fine. However, if you're doing anything that requires login information, it's best to avoid using these unsecured networks.

Signing up is easy! Here's how:

- Sign into online banking
- Select "Online Statements" under Services; a new window will open
- Review agreement and click on "eSign document"
- A code will appear as a PDF at the bottom of your screen
- Enter the code in the eSign Confirmation Code box
- Review information in the Statement Delivery Preference
- Select "next"
- Select "enroll"

# **DON'T LET YOUR ACCOUNT HIBERNATE**

At Community Powered, we understand that life happens and accounts may go unused. Maybe you moved, simply forgot you had an account, or a family member opened an account for you. Whatever the reason, it's easy to avoid a dormant account.

An account is considered dormant if it has less than \$200 and 12 months of no activity. The Credit Union charges a \$5 per-month fee on dormant accounts. To avoid this fee, simply make a deposit or withdrawal, or maintain a balance of \$200 or more in your account.
